The Youth Council at Pinnacle Presbyterian Church is comprised of a small group of Sr. High students who provide input on youth activities and events. Youth on the council may also have a role in the creation and implementation of youth activities. Students on the council represent the larger youth group and participate in various aspects of the Pinnacle Presbyterians Youth Ministry.

The Youth Council Team Member shall ...

- **Express personal faith in Jesus Christ**
- **Serve as an example, role model**, in Christian conduct and character
- **Actively participate, through your regular attendance, in the Senior High Youth Program and special events.**
- **Provide leadership** by helping be responsible for the planning and carrying out of the various events and activities throughout the year.
- **Commit time** to the program by your presence and prayers.
- **Commit to communicate** by sharing your opinions, ideas and concerns with the group and/or with its adult leaders; being willing to talk and lead discussions in small groups,
- **Demonstrate enthusiasm and support** for planned events by, welcoming new people at events, inviting friends to events and being positive
- **Remain open to learn and grow in the Christian faith.**

The youth council will meet once a month. Meeting times and dates will be determined once the council members are selected to best meet the scheduling needs of the council members. Requesting a year commitment of the students who are selected to serve.
